Here is a quick summary of financial activity since our meeting on January 27th. This report includes the bank statement from January, attached.

I. FINANCES REVIEW (Amount & Sources of Moneys Received, Amounts of Disbursements, Amount of Cash on Hand, Receivables Amount, Copy of Bank Statement):

- Met on February 3rd w/ 3 members of the Cayuga Bird Club Board - Stephanie Herrick, Tim Gallagher, & Chris Tessegli-Hymes
- Discussed common history surrounding Louis Aggasiz Fuertes & The LAF Arch.
- CBC is advocate for the Arch to be historically preserved – they are going to use their connections to engage in conversations with a) Cornell Lab of Ornithology @ Sapsucker Woods & b) Friends of Stewart Park (Renwick Bird Sanctuary) to explore interest and options for a new home for the Arch.
- CBC -March Board Meeting Agenda to discuss partnership with CBSAA regarding contributions for the historical preservation and sustanment of the Arch.
 - We would like to approach NYS / LDC to inquire for permission to remove the footings for potential re-use.

I continue to urge the board to schedule a meeting with the Baden-Powell Council for the purpose of establishing a formal & document partnership within and for the explicit purpose that all future developments and communications regarding programming within the namesake or entity of “Camp Barton” with either NYS Parks and or the LDC, be inclusive of the CBSAA.

I feel that the CBSAA should make all efforts to enter into either an MOU, or a Partnership Agreement with the Baden-Powell Council that provides the CBSAA verbal, and administrative involvement in all things concerning the namesake/entity Camp Barton.

Why should we do this:

- ✓ At this time, I feel that the Baden-Powell Council is not adequately capable of representing “Camp Barton” or Badges at Barton, or any Cub programming that occurs within the namesake. Likewise, since 2021, the Baden-Powell Council has shown little / minimal commitment to programs conducted under the namesake “Camp Barton” in terms of communications, promotions, infrastructure, and development. These have allowed for the efforts of volunteers of the CBSAA, Taughannock District, and Camp Barton supporters to determine the ability of the program to occur.
- ✓ Navigating the future with NYS and the LDC needs to be coordinated with a common vision and purpose that satisfies the needs of both the council and the CBSAA, we as the CBSAA are not representing our own goals, purposes, and visions when we are spoken for by the BPC to the governing bodies that exist.
- ✓ The longer we wait to take action on this item, the further we are excluded from developments at the park that could otherwise be influenced and supported by our association.
- ✓ This path is also a first step onto a potential path which provides the CBSAA opportunity to have a “seat at the table” for the park as a whole, not just Scouting.
- ✓ We must take action towards the protection of the past, present, and future of Camp Barton we must no longer be negligent of this objective.

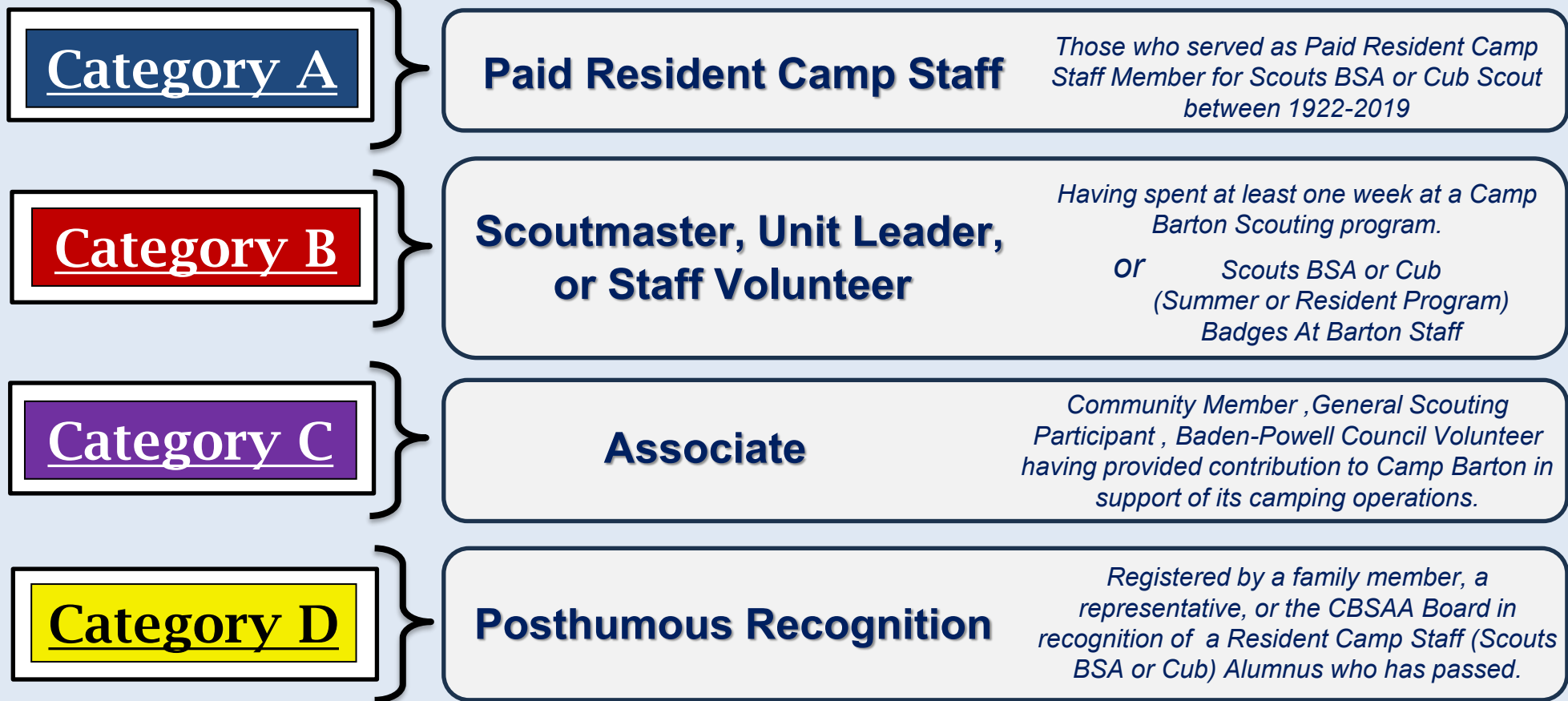

LDC Meeting Summary

Board Representation & Leadership

- New Representative: Elizabeth Weatherby has officially replaced Rich Goldman as the Ulysses LDC representative.
- Officer Elections: The following members have been re-elected to their positions:
 - Chair: R. Hart
 - Vice Chair: K. Olsen
 - Secretary: E. Weatherby
 - Treasurer: B. Carver
- Membership Note: Due to non-payment of LDC shares, Covert is no longer on the board; consequently, no member from that entity was re-elected.

Policy & Operations

- Bylaws: Rhordan led a discussion regarding new bylaws and policies; it was determined that no changes are needed at this time.
- Safety & Liability: The LDC is requesting Seneca County to weigh in on a "no swimming" policy and a "hold harmless" agreement for the LDC.
