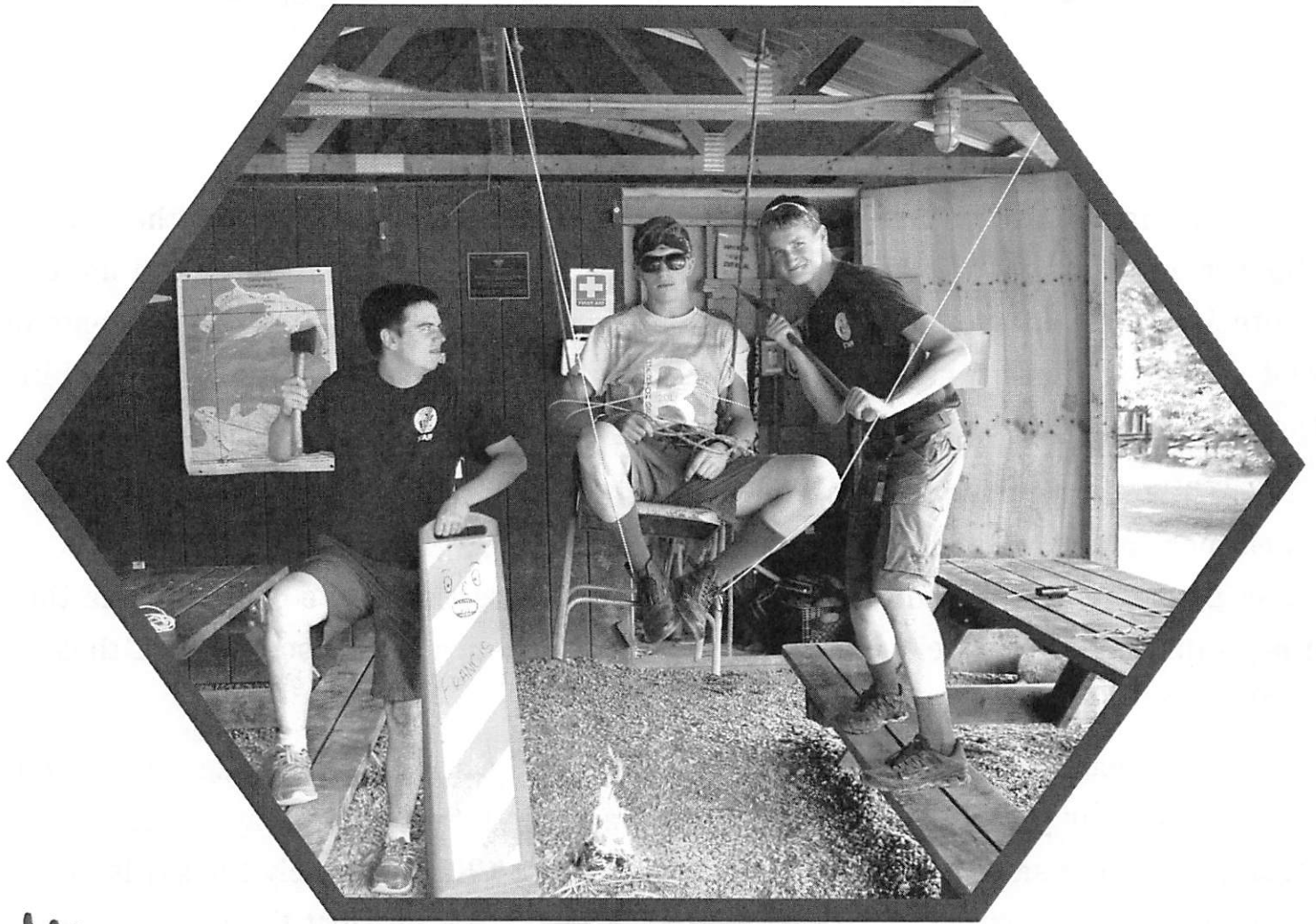

... and then I woke up.

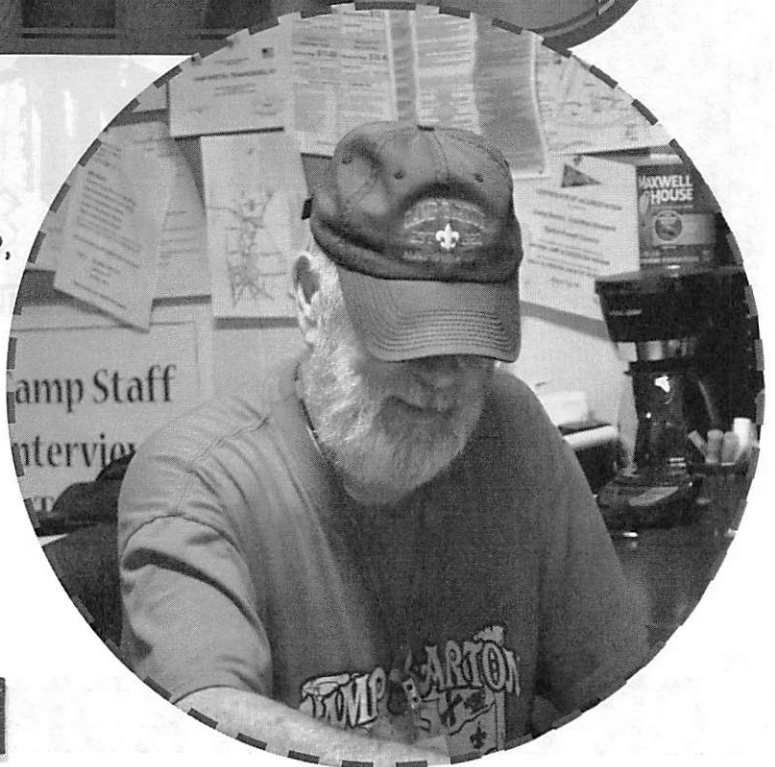
