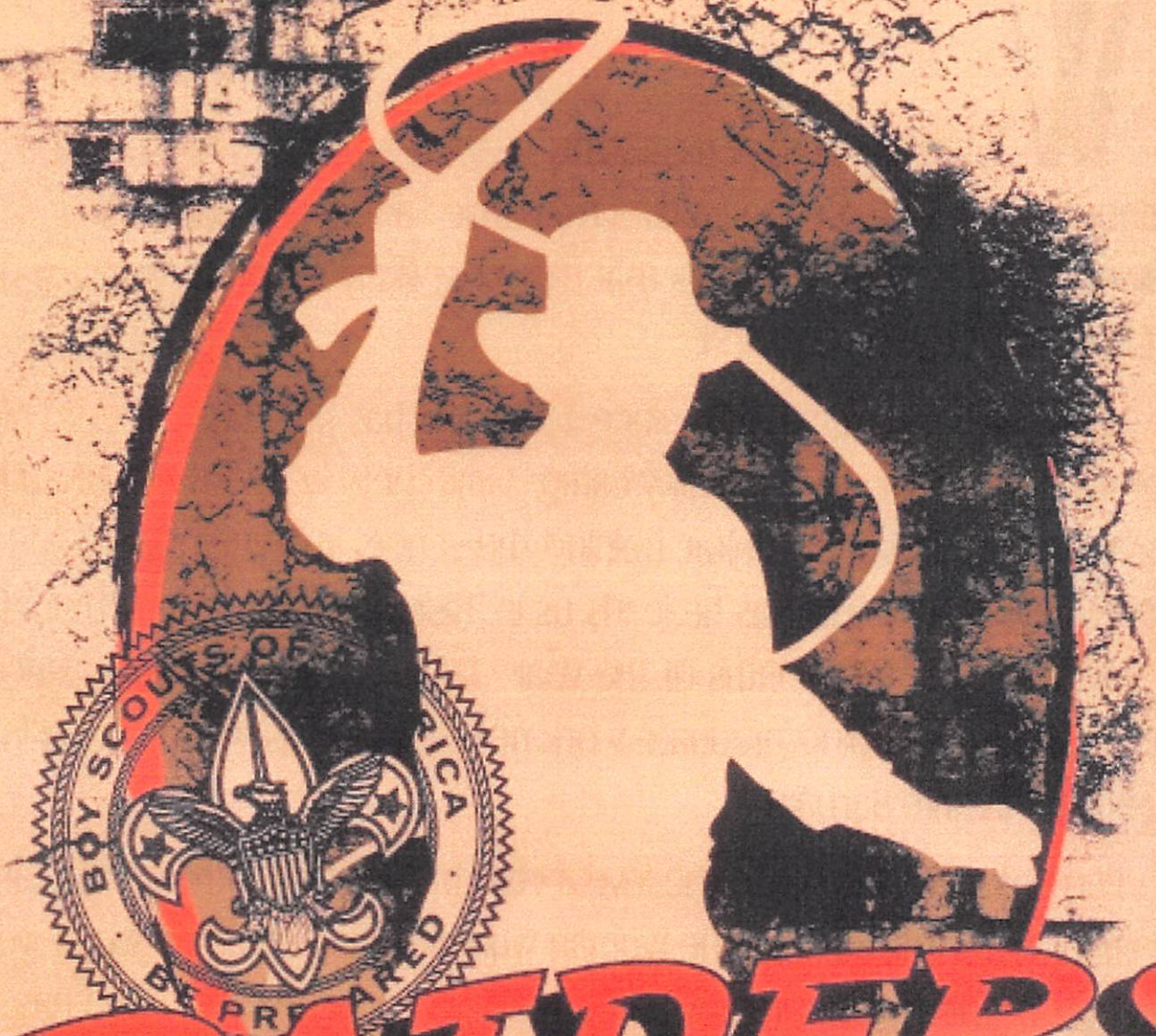

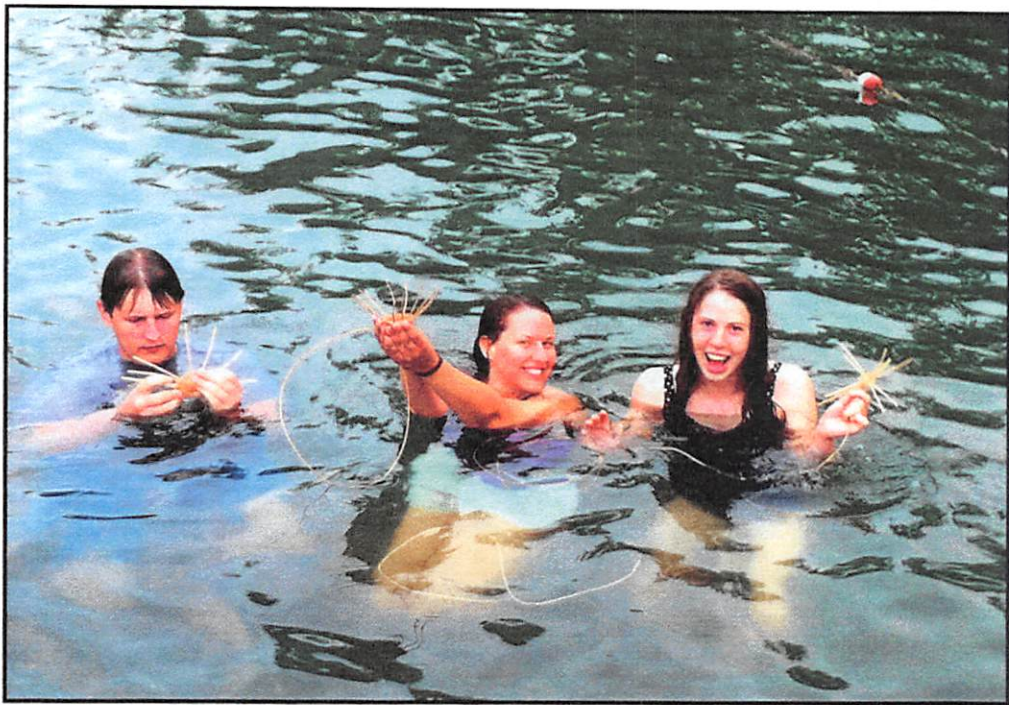

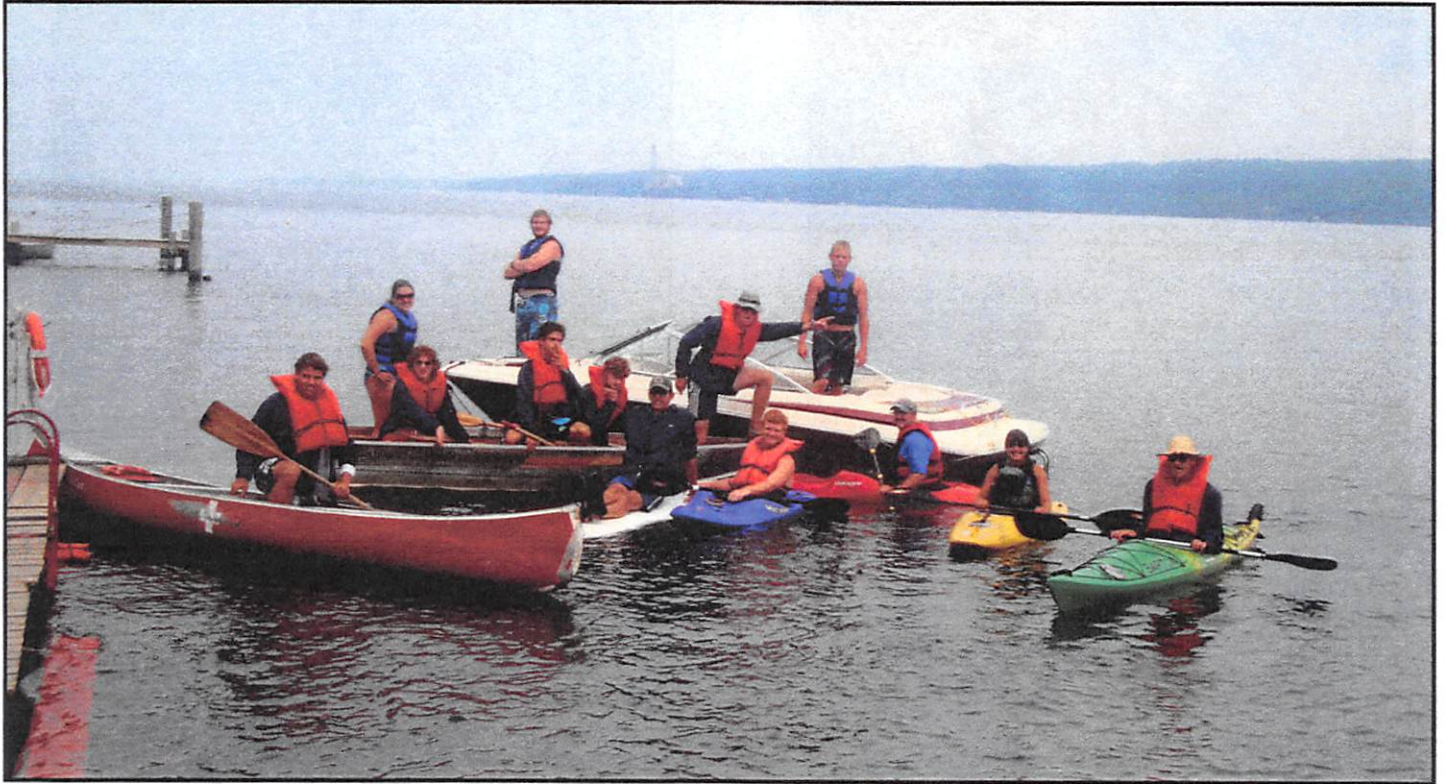




# WATERFRONT

# KITCHEN

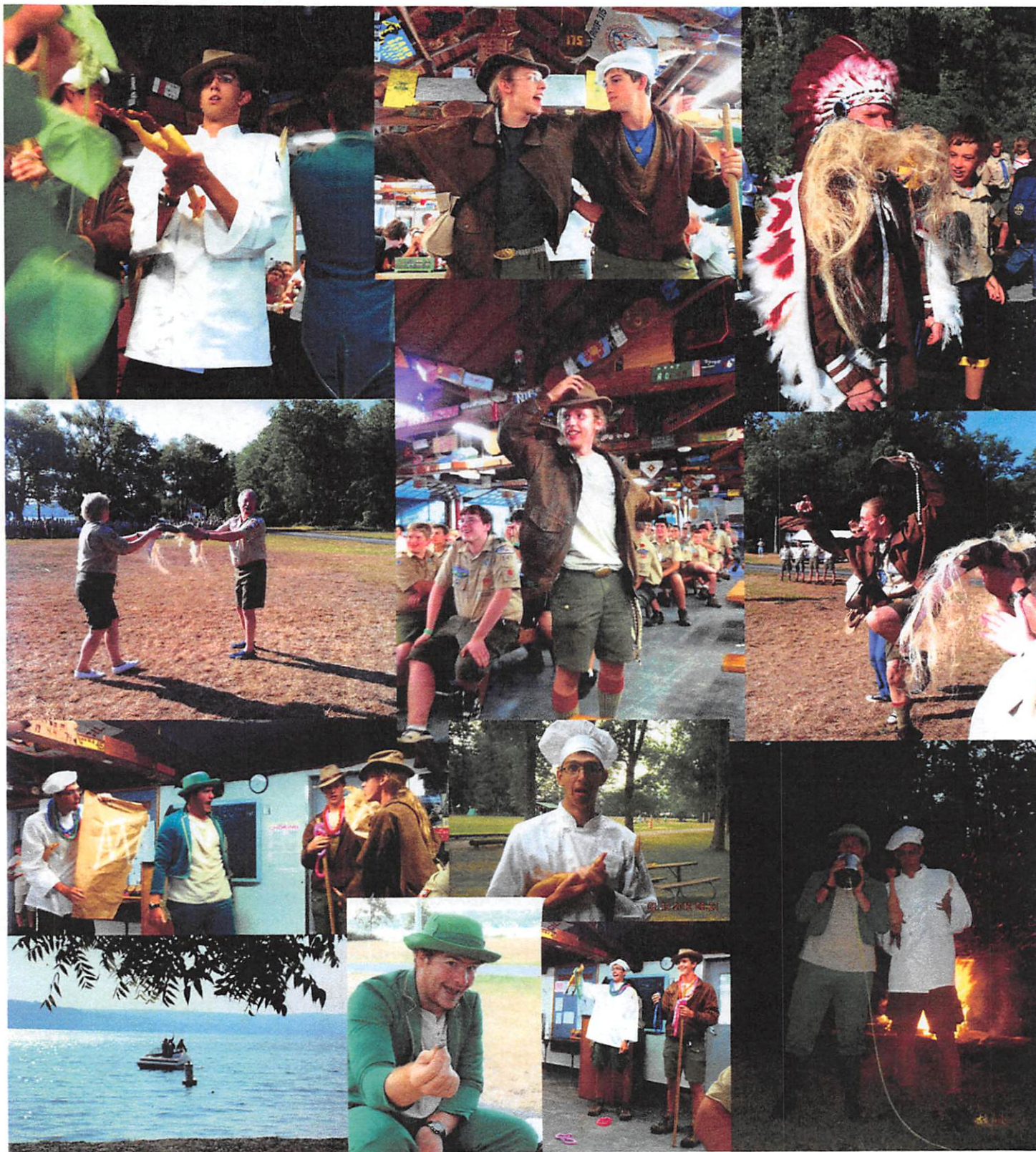
